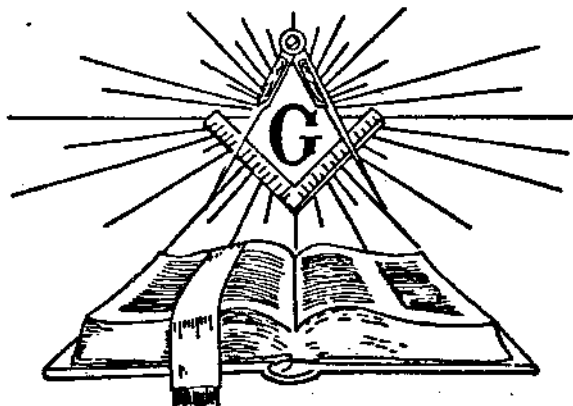

Time Line History Of Building

- 9-30-88 A saturday meeting of Pike Lodge to display the first preliminary plans & architectural sketches
- 9-15-88 Potential buyer for old Pike Lodge Building
- 10-20-88 Pike Brothers vote unanimously to sell old lodge building
- 3-16-89 Pike Lodge accepts offer of \$ 45,000 for old lodge building
- 4- 6-89 Pike accepts Southports offer to meet in their Temple
- 4-20-89 Pike stores furnishings in semi-trailer at Falcon mink ranch
- 5- 9-89 Pike begins meeting at Southport Temple
- 6-15-89 Pike makes offer to purchase 10 acres of land at 4320 Washington Road
- 9-21-89 Pike signs contract with architect to make preliminary drawings & plans
- 10-19-89 Ten acres of land rezoned and annexed to city of Kenosha
- 3-30-90 Land purchase is finally consummated
- 3-17-90 Demolition of old barn, garage, coup, and lean-to is begun
- 8- 7-90 Morton Buildings, Inc. is authorized to proceed with building plans
- 10-18-90 Plans and costs for a Morton Building is presented to Pike Lodge Brothers. They vote unanimously to proceed with project
- 11-15-90 Grand Master, Dean T. Massey, approves building plans with newly designed front entrance and other modifications
- 11-29-90 Trustees of Pike Lodge sign contract with Morton Buildings to construct a new lodge building
- 1-17-91 Knights of Columbus, Marion Council, donate approximately a parcel of land 75' x 75' to Pike Lodge
- 2-21-91 Pike votes to establish Masonic Properties of Kenosha, Inc.
- 1-27-91 Southport Lodge Votes to join Pike Lodge in the adventure of building the new lodge building

- 3-23-91 Ground breaking ceremony performed by Grand Master, Dean T. Massey
- 4-25-91 Building permits were issued
- 5-16-91 Morton Buildings delivers materials for new building to site---construction begins
- 5-19-91 Cornerstone Laying Ceremony conducted by Grand Master, Dean T. Massey
- 6- 6-91 Masonic Properties of Kenosha, Inc. is Officially registered with the state of Wis.
- 7-18-91 Pike & Southport elect members to the Board of Directors of Masonic properties, Inc.
- ;3- 4-92 Occupancy permit granted and first official meeting of both lodges in the new facilities was held jointly
- 5- 9-92 Lodge building was officially dedicated by Grand Master, Benjamin F. Detroy
