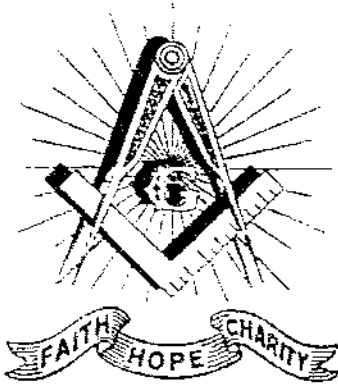

(From the Minutes)

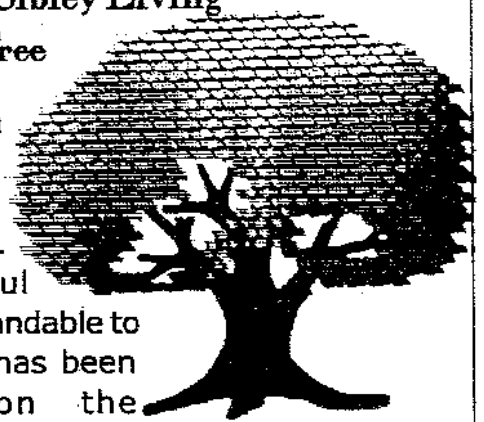
- 1) Brother's Wayne Budwick and Brad Sellers passed excellent proficiency exams in the Fellowcraft Degree.
