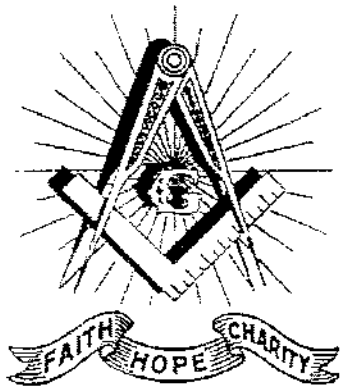

If you do not have your 2005 card and you have paid your dues, call Bruce at 654-6693.

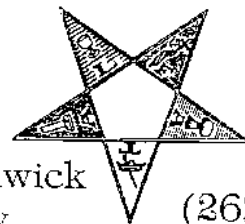

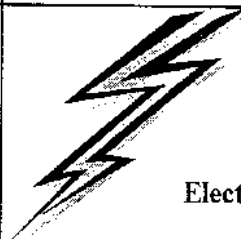

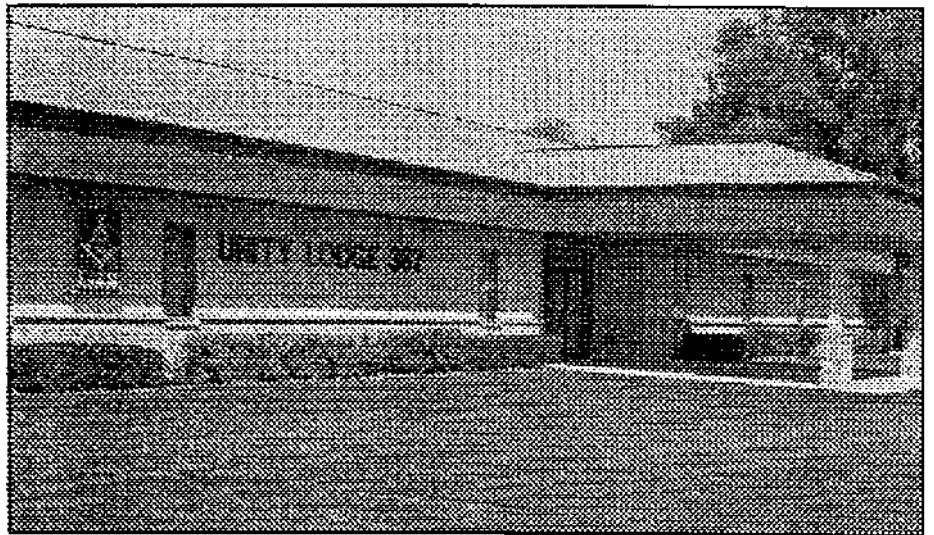
