

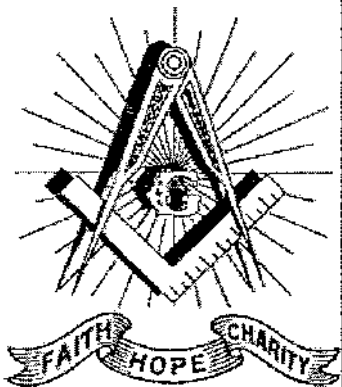

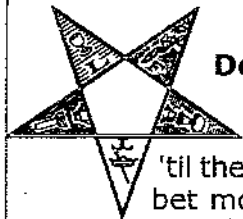

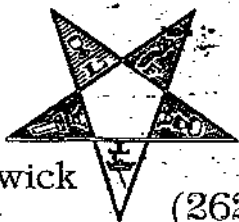

Like many of you, I look at the Best Seller list of books in the newspaper for good reading material. I don't read much fiction, but I do like non-fiction and self-improvement books. Topping the charts recently is a book called "Winning" by Jack & Suzy Welch. Jack, as you may know, is the very successful former CEO of General Electric. Notable people like Warren E. Buffet, former Mayor of New York, Rudy Giuliani, and Bill Gates refer to him as one of the best managers and innovators of recent times. I read his book to glean information from the business world that could be applied to Masonry.

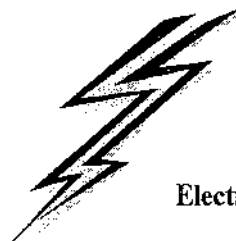
