

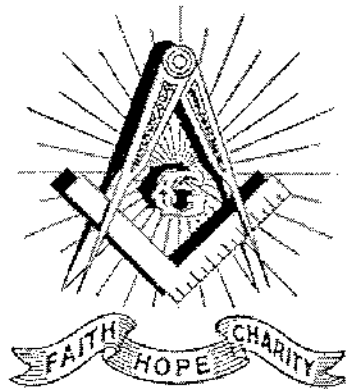

Line Officers. If you are going to attend Session, please call me so I can get credentials out to you. Remember, we will be dark on May 15th.

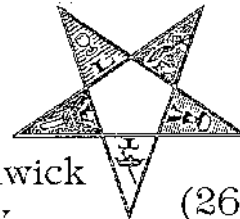

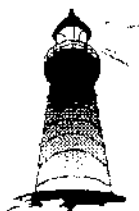

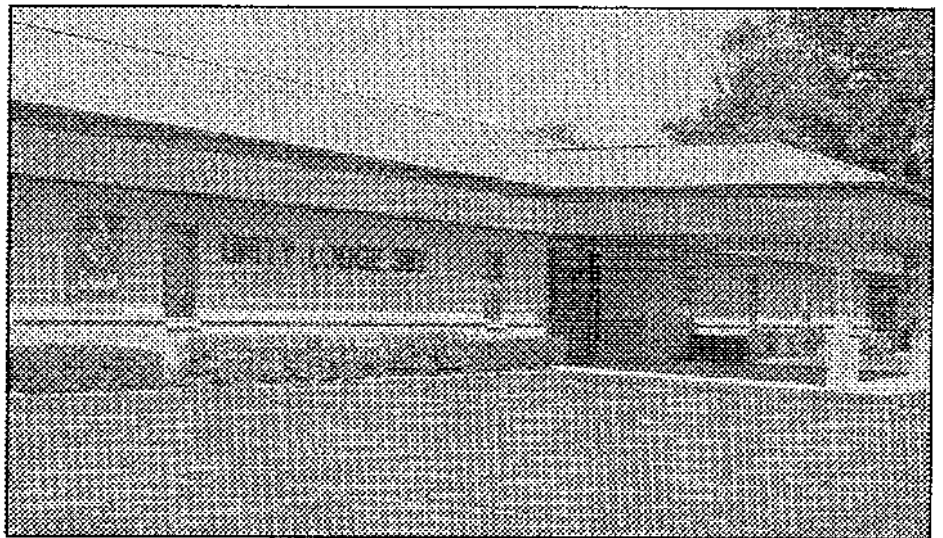
