The outside of the Lodge could use a paint job. If you want to volunteer, please let Vince Shuler know...if we get enough help, we can do it in one day.


At our last Stated Meeting, a dues increase was discussed and the lodge members are going to vote on it at our April 16, 2009 meeting...Try and attend this meeting.
