I would like to take this opportunity to thank all of you for honoring me with the privilege to serve as your Worshipful Master Elect for the coming year.


It is with great pride and humility that I accept the challenge to serve our Unity Lodge. I only hope that I can take on this position with the strength and endurance required to fulfill my role.


