We have a few events planned for April, on the 9th we will be raising Bro. Ben Fox.

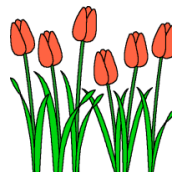




